PEDESTRIANS

67.01 Use Sidewalks

67.02 Walking in Street

67.04 Pedestrian Crossing

67.01 USE SIDEWALKS. Where sidewalks are provided it shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to walk along and upon an adjacent street.

67.02 WALKING IN STREET. Where sidewalks are not provided, pedestrians shall at all times when walking on or along a street, walk on the left side of the street.

67.03 HITCH HIKING. No person shall stand in the traveled portion of a street for the purpose of soliciting a ride from the driver of any private vehicle.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.331)

67.04 PEDESTRIAN CROSSING. Every pedestrian crossing a roadway at any point other than within a marked crosswalk or within an unmarked crosswalk at an intersection shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles upon the roadway.
